# MINUTES HARRISON COUNTY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION July 17, 2018

The regular July meeting of the Harrison County Development Commission was called to order at 8:20 am on Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at Harrison County Development Commission, Gulfport, Mississippi.

#### Review of Rail Bids

Staff recommended Mississippi Export Railroad because of their proximity to HCDC and existing relationships in MS. And re-engage John Elliott rail consultant to study the rail in BBID and to look at the 3 rail bids. Commissioner Atherton made a motion to engage John Elliott with Strategic Rail in a contract to help evaluate rail proposals and bring back a recommendation to the Commission and the contract to not exceed in the amount \$70,000.00 and let Legal Counsel review the rail proposals and how HCDC should proceed and seconded by Commissioner Conway. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

## Beatline Extension Build Grant Letter of Support

Commissioner Castiglia made a motion to support the Beatline extension letter and seconded by Commissioner Schloegel. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

• Harrison County Public Access Intermodal Facility BUILD Grant Staff recommended the Grant with 7.6 million dollars total and HCDC to spend \$750,000.00 with the money being in the budget for a 5.4 million dollar grant. Commissioner Conway made a motion to allow staff to spend the \$750,000.00 and submit the Harrison County Public Access Intermodal Facility BUILD Grant and seconded by Commissioner Daniels. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

## Harrison County Utility Authority (HCUA)

Commissioner Atherton made a motion for Harrison County Utility Authority (HCUA) to take over the sewer system in the Long Beach Industrial District and Harrison County Development Commission (HCDC) to keep the water system and seconded by Commissioner Castiglia. Commissioner Atherton, Castiglia, Schloegel, and Levens voted yea. Commissioner Kirkland and Bentz-Mustered abstained. Commissioner LaRosa and Gollott voted nah. Motion passed with 6-2 affirmative vote.
